PHOTOGRAPHY IN NATURE with Gustafson Photo Safari

Turtles hatch on a secluded beach, resplendent quetzals glide through a cloud forest, and the green macaw's insistent call breaks the silence of the rainforest, here in Costa Rica at the ends of the Earth. This small, friendly country is home to a great diversity of habitats including the lowland tropical rainforest, an outstanding venue to capture shots of a lifetime! The forest is alive with striking plants and colorful flowers, insects, reptiles, amphibians, and a variety of bird life including toucans, parrots, jacamars, hummingbirds, and motmots. Images from Costa Rica that inspire a full chapter in To the Ends of the Earth Volume 3 The Natural World include a newly hatched green sea turtle entering the surf for the first time, a two-toed sloth peering through green vines as it clings to its perch on a rainforest tree, and a lemon yellow eyelash pit viper relaxing on a thin branch. With tips, techniques and personal instruction from a top digital photography expert, Todd Gustafson, you will return with an amazing portfolio of colorful images and a new sense of wonder about the tropics.

NOVEMBER 28 - SAN JOSÉ

Upon arrival in San José, please proceed to clear Immigration & Customs and exit the airport secure area, where you will meet with your Holbrook Representative for your transfer to the hotel. This afternoon enjoy time on your own to photograph the famous gardens at Hotel Bougainvillea. Check-in starts at 3:00 pm. At 6:00 pm there will be an orientation to the program by Todd Gustafson and your Costa Rican Group Leader followed by a Welcome Dinner at the hotel. There is no specific arrival time required; however, if you wish to participate in the Orientation and dinner, we suggest arriving no later than 4:30 pm. If you would like a pre hotel night, arrangements can be made for an additional cost. *Overnight at Hotel Bougainvillea.* (D)

NOVEMBER 29 - TORTUGUERO

After optional early morning photography around the gardens, transfer to the dock for the boat trip to Tortuguero. Breakfast will be en route. Upon arrival enjoy lunch and settle into your room. This afternoon take a boat ride in Tortuguero National Park, photographing species such as iguanas, monkeys, and a variety of birds. *Overnight at Evergreen Lodge. (BLD)*

NOVEMBER 30 - TORTUGUERO

Continue exploring Tortuguero by boat during the morning and afternoon. Free time will be available to photograph the lodge grounds on your own. *Overnight at Evergreen Lodge. (BLD)*

DECEMBER 1 - TORTUGUERO

Continue exploring Tortuguero by boat in the morning and in the afternoon. Explore the lodge grounds for photography on your own. *Overnight at Evergreen Lodge. (BLD)*

DECEMBER 2 - TORTUGUERO

Continue exploring Tortuguero by boat in the morning and in the afternoon. Explore the lodge grounds for photography on your own. *Overnight at Evergreen Lodge. (BLD)*

DECEMBER 3 - SARAPIQUÍ

Early morning photography session around the lodge. After breakfast depart for the dock and then travel to Sarapiquí by bus, stopping for lunch at a local restaurant along the way. En route stop at CopeArte to photograph bats, owls, hummingbirds, and other species. Arrive at the lodge late in the afternoon. After dinner, enjoy a guided hike around the lodge trails looking for nocturnal species. *Overnight at Selva Verde Lodge & Rainforest Reserve.* (BLD)

DECEMBER 4 - SARAPIQUÍ

After an early breakfast, transfer to OTS La Selva Biological Station for a guided hike and photography. Lunch at Selva Verde Lodge. In the afternoon, return to La Selva Biological Station for more photography. After dinner, take another optional guided nocturnal hike around the lodge. Tonight, dinner will be at the

Italian restaurant at Selva Verde downstairs. Overnight at Selva Verde Lodge & Rainforest Reserve. (BLD)

DECEMBER 5 - SAVEGRE

Early morning birding photography on the lodge grounds. After breakfast head for the Talamanca mountains and Savegre, stopping for lunch en route. In the afternoon, explore the trails looking for the Resplendent Quetzal, and visit Miriam's with your guide. Overnight at Savegre Hotel, Natural Reserve & Spa. (BLD)

DECEMBER 6 - SAVEGRE

Spend the morning exploring the property's trails, which wind through mostly virgin forest consisting of hundred-year-old trees, multicolored plants, mushrooms, insects, amphibians, and mammals. Altitudes vary from 7,220 to 11,384 feet. Savegre is a paradise for birders and is known as one of the best places in the country to observe the Resplendent Quetzal. During your stay, you will also enjoy hummingbird photography. In the afternoon, visit Batsú Gardens for bird photography. Overnight at Savegre Hotel, Natural Reserve & Spa. (BLD)

DECEMBER 7 - SAN JOSÉ

After an early breakfast, there will be a group transfer to the international airport for your flight home. Check-in for international flights is three hours prior to departure time. The drive from Savegre to the airport is approximately two hours; if you are arranging your flights independently please reserve a flight no earlier than 12:30 pm. Additional transfers can be arranged at additional cost. We hope you enjoyed your program and look forward to having you on others in the future.
