Zapata Swamp Biosphere Reserve

February 17-24, 2019

Please join us for the 6th Annual International Nature Photography Contest, held in the Zapata Swamp. At more than 1 million acres, the Zapata Swamp is one of the most extensive remnants of coastal Caribbean biodiversity left in the region. The area encompasses blue-water beaches, forests, rivers, lakes, flooded caverns, ponds and swamp prairies.

At this unprecedented time in Cuba's history, when U.S. travelers are flocking to see the island nation, this is an exciting opportunity to connect with resident photographers, learn about the country's fascinating natural areas and join like-minded people from all over the world who are as enthusiastic about nature and photography as you are!

CONTEST HIGHLIGHTS

- Contestants may submit photos in the following categories: Birds in Flight; Endemic Birds; Non-endemic Birds; Nature.
- Photographers may submit up to five images in each category, with works made in the Zapata Swamp during the event.
- Images should be submitted in JPEG format (300 dpi resolution).
- Full computer stations will be provided for editing. Minor corrections may be made for color, definition, contrast, etc. Photomontages and manipulated images will not be accepted.
- The jury will include noted Cuban and international photographers, who will judge photos on content as well as artistic and technical quality.

ITINERARY

BLD = BREAKFAST, LUNCH, DINNER

FEBRUARY 17 - HAVANA

Upon arrival in Havana, transfer to the hotel accompanied by contest staff. You will have the remainder of the afternoon and evening at leisure. Hotel check in is at 3 pm. *Overnight at Comodoro Havana Hotel.*

FEBRUARY 18 - ZAPATA

This morning transfer to Playa Girón. Welcome cocktail prior to lunch then at 4 pm attend contest accreditation and technical council. Inauguration dinner this evening. *Overnight at Playa Girón Hotel. (BLD)*

FEBRUARY 19 - ZAPATA

Depart for the trails at 6:30 am. You will visit two trails, one in the morning and one in the afternoon. The trails to choose from are Sopillar, Las Salinas, Los Hondones, Enigma de las Rocas, Las Bermejas, and La Turba. Lunch will be at a local restaurant. Return to the hotel at 6 pm. *Overnight at Playa Girón Hotel. (BLD)*

FEBRUARY 20 - ZAPATA

Depart for the trails at 6:30 am. You will visit two trails, one in the morning and one in the afternoon. In the morning you will have time to select your photo submissions and deliver them to jury. The deadline for photo entries is 1 pm. Attend the Closing and Award Ceremony this evening, followed by dinner and a show to celebrate. *Overnight at Playa Girón Hotel. (BLD)*

FEBRUARY 23 - HAVANA

At 8 am have breakfast at the hotel. At 9 am proceed to check out and transfer to Havana. Explore Old Havana on your own for the remainder of the day. *Overnight at Comodoro Havana Hotel. (B)*

FEBRUARY 24 - DEPARTURE

This morning you will be transferred to the Havana airport for your flight back to the U.S. (B)

PROGRAM PRICING

Cost is per person in double occupancy.
