- Learn about the engineering marvel that is the Panama Canal at the famed Miraflores Locks.

ITINERARY

SEPTEMBER 16 - PANAMA CITY

Upon arrival at the Panama City International Airport, after clearing customs and collecting your luggage, you will be met and transferred to the hotel for check-in. Enjoy a welcome dinner this evening at seafood restaurant Peach Fuzz International. *Overnight at Radisson Panama Canal. (D)*

SEPTEMBER 17 - PANAMA CITY

This morning, transfer from the breaking waves of the Pacific Ocean to the calm waters of the Caribbean. Turn off the main road between Panama City and Colón toward Portobelo, entering a green landscape with dramatic hills where the campesinos ride their horses and tend their cattle. What was once an important colonial port for exporting silver to Spain is today a sleepy bayside town. Ruins of several forts and batteries are still standing, forming part of a UNESCO World Heritage Site that is recognized as a significant example of 17th- and 18th-century military architecture. Portobelo is also home to the Iglesia de San Felipe and its statue of the Black Christ, a centuries-old figure whose origins are unknown but which is said to have washed up on the town's shores. Other monuments of interest include the Royal Customs House and the Hospital Chapel. Enjoy lunch at a restaurant in the nearby community of Maria Chiquita. Afterward, return to Panama City for a guided walking tour of the historical district, known as Casco Viejo or Casco Antiguo. Built in the late 1800s and early 1900s, Casco Viejo's parks and narrow streets are lined with colorful buildings representative of Spanish, French, and early American architectural styles. Visit an art museum in the converted strong house known as Las Bóvedas, which was once used for storing gold. Other points of interest are the famed flat arch of Santo Domingo Church, the beautiful gold-plated altar of the San Jose Church, the National Cathedral, the Presidential Palace, the Plaza Bolívar, and the Plaza Herrera. Also visit the Afro-Antillean Museum, which features exhibits on the history of Panama's West Indian Afro-Panamanian community, including their contributions to the building of the Panama Canal and its railway. Overnight at Radisson Panama Canal. (BL)

SEPTEMBER 18 - PANAMA CITY

Take a half-day tour of the Panama Canal via the Miraflores Locks. Watch a presentation about the canal's history on the largest IMAX screen in the world. Then, return to your hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day at your leisure. This evening, have dinner at Mercado de Mariscos. *Overnight at Radisson Panama Canal. (BD)*

SEPTEMBER 19 - PANAMA CITY

Today, take a ferry to the Pearl Islands: the best place to explore the beautiful waters off the coast of Panama City. This is also the season for whale watching, providing thrills as you're traveling to and from the islands. Once there, enjoy a day at the beach, which includes snorkeling, lunch, beverages, and snacks. *Overnight at Radisson Panama Canal. (BL)*

SEPTEMBER 20 - DEPARTURE

Late this morning, you will be transferred to the Panama City International Airport for your non-stop flight back to Atlanta. Welcome home! (B)
